

REGION II ANNUAL REPORT

Region II had many disasters in 2010 and many volunteers were involved in clean up. Kentucky experienced a lot of flooding, and the Alabama unit monitored the Deep Water Horizon oil spill. The extent of damage from the oil spill is still unknown.

The Western Ohio unit transported 320,000 pounds of carrots to food pantries in Ohio and a semi-load of watermelons to the Toledo area. Eastern Ohio unit completed the Hands on House which helped raise funds for MDS.

Michigan reported 29 tornadoes. The Mississippi and Louisiana units helped clean up and repair roofs after a tornado hit Weir, Mississippi. Over 30 volunteers helped clean up after a tornado in Streeter, Illinois.

The Indiana unit continued to respond in Gary, Indiana, which experienced flooding several years ago along the Calumet River where many homes are uninhabitable. Gary was also one of the summer youth project sites.
