Volunteers were busy this past year in Dulzura and Ramona, California, as well as American Samoa. Additionally, two homes were built in California through the Partnership Home Program. All of these programs have come to a close at this time.

The Arizona unit elected new officers and approved new bylaws. They are also working toward establishing a local project in conjunction with Trinity Mennonite Church to repair homes in a low-income neighborhood.
