



COASTAL BEND, TX RV

Hurricane Harvey – 2017

Location

Coastal Bend is a broad term that includes nine different counties that span along the curved area on the Gulf Coast (including Aransas County, where volunteers will be staying). The climate is generally hot in the summer and mild in the winter. The area is known for fishing and birding, seafood, working ranches, and antiquing.

Disaster

Hurricane Harvey reached tropical storm status on August 17, 2017 and continued to develop and intensify, becoming a category 3 hurricane that finally dissipated on September 3, 2017. It was the costliest natural disaster ever on record in the U.S. and the first major hurricane to make landfall on U.S. soil since 2005. There were 91 confirmed deaths and more than 300,000 people were left without electricity. Many people were displaced and thousands of homes were destroyed or sustained major damage.

MDS Response

MDS has reserved several RV spaces clustered together at Coastal Hideaway RV Park. The sites have both 30- and 50-amp service, as well as water and sewer drops.

MDS work will be primarily interior finish work on new builds. This may include drywall finish, trim, flooring, paint, cabinets, and possibly some siding and exterior paint. There may also be some repair work.

Use GPS to direct you to the Coastal Hideaway RV Park. The physical location of the RV Park is at the south end of the Rockport city limit, close to Aransas Pass. The park is along Highway 35 but set back off the road in a wooded area.
